FUNDING AVAILABLE FOR SOUTH WEST PROJECTS

Do you have a project that will benefit the community?

If so, you may be eligible to apply to the South West Development Commission for funding through the State Government's Royalties for Regions program.

Thanks to the State Government's Royalties for Regions program, each of Western Australia's nine development commissions are running a Regional Grants Scheme and a Community Chest Fund.

The Regional Grants Scheme is aimed at bigger projects that will help attract investment, increase job opportunities and assist in improving quality of life in the regions. People can apply to this scheme for grants between \$50,001 and \$300,000.

The Community Chest Fund is a small grants program, aimed at providing funds for smaller community projects. The fund comprises one-off grants of up to and including \$50,000 to support small, local-driven projects.

Both grants programs can be used to assist with the development of infrastructure, services and community projects that will enhance the provision of social and economic benefits to regional communities.
