

This South West Life Photography Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. By submitting an entry to this promotion the entrant is deemed to accept these Terms and Conditions.
2. The promoter is the South West Development Commission (Level 9, Bunbury Tower, 61 Victoria Street, WA, 6230 ABN 23 250 505 809).
3. Entry to the competition is free.
4. Employees of the promoter and their immediate families are not eligible to win prizes. For the purposes of this competition, "immediate families" means spouse, parent or step-parent, child or step-child, brother, sister, step-brother or step-sister. Entrants under the age of 18 must have the consent of a parent or guardian to enter.
5. Entrants must only submit photographs taken between January 1 2019 (WA time) and June 30 2019 (WA time).
6. Only entries submitted before midnight on June 30 2019 (WA time) will be eligible.
7. To enter, people must submit digital photographs during the promotional period via the form provided on the promoter's website.
8. By entering a photograph in the competition, the entrant confirms:
 - a. The photograph is the entrant's original work.
 - b. The entrant is the sole owner and copyright owner of the photograph.
 - c. The photograph was taken in the South West region of Western Australia between January 1 2019 (WA time) and June 30 2019 (WA time)
 - d. All details provided with your entry are true and accurate.
 - e. The entrant has consent from people in the photograph.
 - f. The entrant ensures that the photograph is not of an offensive, illegal or pornographic nature, or be considered distressing.
 - g. If the entrant is under 18, they have the consent of a parent or guardian to enter.
 - h. The entrant agrees to have their name and photographs published.
 - i. The entrant gives the promoter permission to use the photograph free-of-charge in the calendar and for promotional purposes related to the calendar.
9. Digital photographs entered in the competition must be of high quality. As a guide, images should be between 5MB and 10MB in size, submitted in .jpg format.
10. The objective of the competition is to show the real South West. Therefore, entries should not be overly digitally altered, except for basic lighting, colour correction and cropping.
11. An entrant may submit multiple entries to the promotion.
12. Entries will be judged on relevance, creativity, subject and the level of engagement they inspire. The judges' decisions are final and no correspondence will be entered into.
13. Thirteen winners will be selected to feature in a 2020 wall calendar produced by the promoter. The prize is not redeemable or transferable in any way.

14. Thirteen runner-up winners will also be selected to be printed in the 2020 wall calendar by the promoter. The prize is not redeemable or transferable in any way.
15. The winners will be notified by mail/email. The names of the winners will also be published on the promoter's website – www.swdc.wa.gov.au .
